Participation and Hold-Harmless Agreement

The Virginia Interscholastic Sailing Association (VISA), the MidAtlantic Scholastic Sailing Association (MASSA), and the Interscholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) govern the league and are hereafter referred to as governing organizations. The United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) sets the rules for competitive sailing.

I, the undersigned, give my child, _____, permission to participate in this program. I understand that participation in the activity involves a certain degree of risk. I have carefully considered the risk involved and have given consent for my child to participate in the activity. I understand that participation in the activity is entirely voluntary and requires participants to abide by the rules and standards of conduct. I release the Maury High School Sailing Team, Maury High School Sailing Association, the activity coordinators, coaches, and all employees, volunteers, related parties, or other organizations associated with the activity from any and all claims or liability arising out of this participation.

For safety, my child and I agree that he/she will do the following or he/she will be removed from the program. Because team expenses are based on beginning of season participant numbers, any cost associated with participation in this program will not be refunded.

1. Complete a swim test as administered by the team coach.
2. Wear all required safety gear on or around the equipment, or as specified by the team, officials and/or governing organizations.
3. Follow all safety rules as specified by the team and/or governing organizations.
4. Follow the instructions of the team coaches, advisors, and officials.
5. Follow all sail/racing rules as published by the United States Sailing Association.
6. Demonstrate good sportsmanship and acceptable behavior both on and off the water.
